SSI makes 1_____ payments to people who have low 2____ and few 3_____, and who are age 65 or older, blind, or disabled. SSI is managed by the Social Security Administration (SSA).

- Eligibility
- Income: The SSA calculates if your income disqualifies you from receiving SSI.
- Resources: For individuals, your resources must be worth 4______ or less.
- Disability status: The SSA will determine if you meet the disability criteria. For adults (18+), the SSA is primarily concerned with how your disability affects your ability to 5_______.
- Residence: You must live in the U.S. or the Northern Mariana Islands.
- Citizenship: You must be a U.S. citizen or national. Some non-citizens may qualify.

Application Process

- You can apply online: https://www.ssa.gov/benefits/ssi/.
- You can schedule an appointment at your local Social Security office: 1-800-772-1213, or contact your local Social Security office (http://bit.ly/2MQjl4F).
- The application is long, and the SSA will require documents verifying your resources, income, and disability status.
- If you are applying for children under 18, you will need to complete the Application for Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and a Child Disability Report.
- If your child is receiving SSI, they will go through the Age 18 Redetermination process to determine if they will continue to receive SSI benefits as an adult and how much they will receive.
